## ITINERARY FOR KIWI TRAVEL 11 DAYS NEPAL HIGHLIGHT

### 20 March: Arrival and sightseeing

Arrival at 7:00 AM (Air Arabia). You will be welcomed by our airport representative with a flower garland and then begin your sightseeing tour of **Pashupatinath**, a sacred Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Shiva and an important cremation site. Afterward, you will visit **Boudhanath**, the largest Buddhist stupa in Nepal, where we will also stop for lunch.

Because rooms may not be available so early, we will proceed with sightseeing first and head to the hotel afterward. The official check-in time is 3:00 PM, but we will do our best to arrange an early check-in for you. [Yukhang Hotel](#)



### 21 March: Kathmandu sightseeing (B)

After breakfast, begin your sightseeing with a visit to **Swayambhunath**, the iconic hilltop stupa known as the “Monkey Temple,” offering panoramic views of the Kathmandu Valley and featuring sacred shrines, prayer wheels, and the Buddha’s all-seeing eyes.

Continue to **Kathmandu Durbar Square**, the historic royal palace complex filled with ancient temples, courtyards, and traditional Newari architecture. Here, you will also visit the **Kumari Ghar**, the residence of

the Living Goddess Kumari, and, if timing permits, you may even catch a glimpse of her appearance from the courtyard.

From Durbar Square, enjoy a walking tour through the vibrant alleys of **Asan Bazaar**, one of the oldest and busiest traditional markets in Kathmandu, famous for its spices, local produce, traditional shops, and lively local culture. [Yukhang Hotel](#)



### 22 March: Cable car to Chandragiri, city Patan explore (B)

After an early breakfast, drive to the base of the **Chandragiri Cable Car** and ascend to the hilltop station. At the summit, you can explore the **Baleshwar Mahadev Temple** and enjoy breathtaking panoramic views of the **Himalayan range** and the entire **Kathmandu Valley**, weather permitting. Chandragiri is also known as the historic spot from where King Prithvi Narayan Shah first envisioned unifying Nepal, adding cultural significance to the visit.



After exploring the area, you may enjoy a short scenic walk toward the hotel area on the ridge and take a refreshing break with drinks while soaking in the peaceful hillside setting. Later, return to the cable car station and descend back to the base.

From here, drive to **Patan**, one of the oldest cities in the valley, known for its rich art, culture, and stunning temple architecture. Enjoy a lunch break in Patan before returning to the hotel. [Yukhang Hotel](#)

### 23 March: Drive to Chitwan and activities (B, L, D)

After an early breakfast, begin your scenic drive to **Chitwan**, a journey of approximately six hours through

picturesque landscapes, rural villages, and winding rivers. Upon arrival at the lodge, enjoy lunch and some time to settle in.

In the late afternoon, take a guided **village walk** to explore the traditional lifestyle of the local communities. In the evening, experience a vibrant **Tharu cultural program**, showcasing the unique dance, music, and traditions of the indigenous Tharu people. [Hotel Earthlight](#)



#### 24 March: Full day in Chitwan with activities (B, L, D)

Today is a full day to explore the rich wildlife and natural beauty of **Chitwan National Park**. Activities include **bird watching**, where you can spot a variety of colorful and rare species; a peaceful **canoe ride** along the Rapti River, offering close-up views of marsh crocodiles, water birds, and lush riverbanks; and a thrilling **jeep safari** through the dense forest and grasslands in search of rhinoceros, deer, wild boar, monkeys, and—if you're lucky—the elusive Bengal tiger.

As a responsible and sustainable tour operator, we recommend the **jeep safari** over elephant rides, as we strongly discourage activities that involve harmful training practices or exploitation of animals.

In the evening, relax by the riverside and enjoy a beautiful **sunset** over the Rapti River, the perfect setting to unwind with your favorite drink. [Hotel Earthlight](#)



### 25 March: Drive to Pokhara visiting Bandipur enroute (B)

After breakfast, drive toward Pokhara. En route, visit **Bandipur**, a beautifully preserved **Newari hilltop town** known for its traditional architecture, charming stone-paved streets, and stunning views of the Himalayan panorama. Bandipur offers a peaceful atmosphere, rich culture, and historic temples, making it a wonderful place to stroll and enjoy lunch while taking in its timeless village charm.

After lunch, continue the drive to **Pokhara**, the scenic “**Lake City**,” famous for its crystal-clear lakes, relaxed ambience, and breathtaking views of the Annapurna and Machhapuchhre (Fishtail) mountains. In the evening, experience the serene **Aarati ceremony at Barahi Taal**, followed by a pleasant walk along the lakeside during sunset. [Hotel White Pearl](#)



### 26 March: Optional Helicopter flight to Annapurna Base Camp or Just explore Pokhara (B)

Today, guests have the option to wake up early for an **optional helicopter flight to Annapurna Base Camp**. This breathtaking 1.5 hour journey includes a short stop for coffee while enjoying panoramic views of the **Himalayan peaks**, glaciers, and deep valleys—a truly unforgettable experience. Those who prefer to relax can sleep in and join for a leisurely breakfast.

After breakfast, we will drive to the **Mountaineering Museum**, where you can explore fascinating exhibits on Nepal’s mountaineering history, famous climbers, and rich Himalayan culture. We will then continue to **Davis Falls**, a unique and powerful waterfall that disappears into an underground tunnel, offering a dramatic natural spectacle. Our final stop will be the **World Peace Stupa**, a tranquil hilltop monument known for its spiritual ambience and incredible panoramic views of Pokhara and the Annapurna range on clear days.

From there, we will **trek down** to the lakeside, enjoying the beautiful scenery along the way, and **cross the lake by boat** before returning to the hotel. [Hotel White Pearl](#)



### **27 March: Drive to Kande and trek Australian Camp (B)**

Today is our **trekking day**. After breakfast, drive for about 40 minutes to **Kande**, a scenic viewpoint offering stunning panoramic views of the **Himalayan peaks**. From here, begin the trek to **Australian Camp**, a moderately uphill trail passing through lush forests, quaint villages, and traditional stone steps. The pace is leisurely, as the trek is approximately 2.5 hours, allowing time to enjoy the surroundings and take photos.

Upon arrival at **Australian Camp**, enjoy a relaxing lunch and soak in the breathtaking views. Those with extra energy can explore nearby trails for short hikes around the camp. Australian Camp is renowned for its **panoramic views of the Annapurna range**, and it is an ideal spot to witness both **sunrise and sunset**, making it a truly memorable experience for nature lovers and photographers alike. **Teahouse**



### 28 March: Walk through Dhampus to the valley down to Phedi and, return to Pokhara (B)

Today, wake up early to witness a **brehtaking sunrise** over the Himalayas from Australian Camp. After enjoying the view, have breakfast before starting your trek **down to Dhampus**, a traditional **Gurung village** known for its rich culture and as the home of many soldiers of the Gorkha army. Continue trekking to **Phedi**, where you will meet your vehicle for the drive back to **Pokhara**. Spend the evening relaxing and stay overnight in Pokhara.



### 29 March: Flight to Kathmandu and visit Bhaktapur (B)

After breakfast, take a **domestic flight to Kathmandu**. (Please note that domestic flights in Nepal are often subject to delays, so we appreciate your understanding.) Upon arrival, drive directly to **Bhaktapur**, one of the most beautiful and well-preserved medieval towns in the Kathmandu Valley. Known for its **rich art, culture, and architecture**, Bhaktapur offers a glimpse into Nepal's royal past with its **ancient palaces, intricately carved temples, and the famous Potter's Square**, where traditional pottery is still made by hand.

Enjoy lunch in Bhaktapur, soaking in the town's vibrant atmosphere and historic charm. In the evening, return to your hotel in Kathmandu to relax. [Yukhang Hotel](#)



### 30 March: Departure (B)

Today is a **free day** to relax and enjoy at your own pace. You can explore the vibrant streets of Kathmandu, shop for souvenirs and handicrafts, or indulge in a rejuvenating spa treatment. Later, we will transfer you to the airport for your **departure on Air Arabia at 23:11**.
